## **Committee Charter**

### **Adult Religious Education Committee**

#### **Mission:**

To provide for adults of all ages a wide range of opportunities for deepening their faith through exploring, learning, creating and building Beloved Community. We do this by providing programs that draw from our liberal religious tradition, our Seven Principles, and our Six Sources of Wisdom.

#### **Qualifications for Chair:**

Member of the Fellowship with an interest in learning, a curious attitude and cooperative manner. Willingness to coordinate and work with a diverse group of class instructors and committee volunteers.

#### **Qualifications for Vice-Chair and Members:**

#### **Overall Responsibilities:**

To work with the Director of Lifespan Religious Education in designing and administering a balanced RE program for adults which addresses the needs and interest of the Fellowship. Oversee Adult Religious Education programming and ensure that our Adult Religious Education programs promote and deliver Unitarian Universalism as a spiritual path in its own right, and within this context, to present diverse opportunities for learning and practice which embrace a wide range of belief stances and preferences.

#### **Functions:**

1. Committee chair is a member of the Program Council and participates in their monthly meetings or ensures adequate representation therein.
2. Recruit, select, train and work with committee members.
3. Work closely with other committees, leadership and staff as appropriate to coordinate efforts.
4. Develop and recommend an annual budget to accomplish the committee's work.
5. Use resources wisely.
6. Schedule and facilitate Adult RE committee meetings.
7. Generate ideas for Adult RE classes.
8. Periodically survey GUUF members for topics of interest and institute evaluations from instructors and attendees for feedback.
