Mission:

To provide a meaningful, nurturing environment for our children and youth through programs that support them as they grow physically, mentally and spiritually. Together, we build Beloved Community and develop as leaders, free and creative thinkers, and productive citizens.

Qualifications for Chair:

Member of the Fellowship with interest in and care for the physical, mental and spiritual growth of the children and youth in our congregation. Experience with RE teaching, coordinating and/or committee work. Curiosity, common sense and a cooperative spirit.

Qualifications for Vice-Chair and Members:

Member of the Fellowship with interest in and care for the physical, mental and spiritual growth of the children and youth in our congregation. Curiosity, common sense and a cooperative spirit.

Overall Responsibilities:

To work with the Director of Lifespan Religious Education to design and deliver a balanced RE program for children and youth that supports the needs and interests of the Fellowship. Help to coordinate activities that supplement and support RE programs.

Functions:

1. Committee chair is a member of the Program Council and participates in their monthly meetings or ensures representation therein
2. Recruit, train and work with committee members and CYRE volunteers
3. Work closely with other committees, leadership and staff as needed
4. Develop and recommend an annual budget to accomplish the committee's work
5. Use resources wisely
6. Work with DLRE and other committee members to assure smooth functioning of CYRE programs
7. Provide ongoing training and support for CYRE volunteers
